

Policy Title RECIPROCAL BORROWING AND NONRESIDENT USE

Policy Number

3.3

I. Purpose

a. The Board of Trustees of the Camas Public Library finds that by sharing materials and services between libraries, it provides broader service to the taxpayer and uses public resources more efficiently.

II. Reciprocal Borrowing

- a. The Camas Public Library will provide library services free of charge to any person who lives within the boundaries of a political jurisdiction that provides tax-supported public library services.
- b. The Library may enter into agreement in order to provide reciprocal borrowing or other services for Camas residents, and for the patrons of these other libraries, without a fee to the individual library users. For information on specific reciprocal borrowing agreements, see Appendix 4.

III. Nonresident Fees

- a. Persons not living within the boundaries of a political jurisdiction providing tax-supported public library services shall be assessed a nonresident use fee.
- b. The Library shall assess the nonresident use fee annually as part of the City's Fee Schedule.
