

Notice of Application and Public Hearing Franklin Duplex South (File No. CUP17-02)

A public hearing will be held on Tuesday, April 4, 2017 at 5:00 p.m., or soon thereafter, before the city's Hearings Examiner for Franklin Duplex South. The hearing will be located at City Hall at 616 NE 4th Avenue, Camas, WA 98607. The applicant, Timber Grove, LLC proposes to construct a duplex at 4033 NE Franklin Street, within a single family zone, Residential 7,500 (R-7.5). The development of a duplex in a single family zone requires approval of a Conditional Use Permit. The application was considered to be technically complete on February 27, 2017. The standards for evaluating the application can be found within the Camas Municipal Code, at Conditional Use Permits, Section 18.43.050: https://www.municode.com/library/wa/camas/codes/code_of_ordinances.

It is preferable that written comments be received at least a week prior to the public hearing, in order to be available with the online agenda and materials. With that said, comments can also be accepted during the public hearing.
