 - b. Data collection.
 - c. Existing conditions and future needs analysis.
 - d. Agency coordination meetings.
 - e. Improvement alternatives analysis.
 - f. Advisory group meetings.
 - g. TIF alternatives analysis.
 - h. TIF Update recommendations.
 - i. Adoption process.
 - j. Final TIF Update recommendation report or technical memo.
- 8. Completing all tasks within nine months from the kickoff meeting.

 - a. Provide specific examples of projects completed including Agency, Description of work completed and dates.
- 4) Familiarity with relevant codes and standards = 10%;
- 5) Ability to meet schedule = 10%;
- 6) Past performances/references and other considerations = 10%.

Consultants are encouraged to submit their statements in the format and order of the above listed evaluation criteria. Please limit the size of submittals, including tables of contents, appendices, illustrations, charts, graphs, cover letters, and any other information, to 14 pages or up to 7 double-sided sheets with text no smaller than size 10 font on 8-1/2" x 11" paper. Two additional 11" x 17" sheets are allowed as part of submittal. **Please do not submit cost proposals at this time.**
