



## Notice of Open House

**City of Camas to Host an Open House on the NW Camas Meadows Drive/NW Larkspur Street Improvements Project. The Open House will be held on Tuesday, July 11, 2017, from 5:30 p.m. – 7:00 p.m. at Camas Fire Station 42 located at 4321 NW Parker St., Camas, WA 98607.**

The City of Camas invites the public to an Open House to learn about the City's plan to widen NW Larkspur Street between NW Lake Road and the existing barricade at the north end. The road widening project will include construction of left turn lanes, bike lanes, sidewalks, median, stormwater, utilities, illumination and signal modifications. The City will also have information available on the Parklands Development and the Village at Camas Meadows Development projects, which will jointly be extending NW Larkspur Street to connect to Camas Meadows Drive.

The Open House will be an informal, drop-in style event, with staff available at information displays to discuss the project and answer questions throughout the duration. The public is invited to attend at any time between 5:30 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. The Open House will be held at the Camas Fire Station 42 in the Community Conference Room. Please enter using the front (east) entrance to the facility.

### **Project Background**

The City successfully applied for a Transportation Improvement Board Fuel Tax grant for this roadway improvement project. This project will provide a new network connection and complete the gap between NW Lake Road and NW Payne Street. The goal of the project is to improve safety and accessibility for pedestrian, bicyclists, and motorists. The project is being funded through a combination of local and state funds. The total cost will be approximately \$4,375,000.

### **Project Construction**

Construction is anticipated to commence in the summer of 2018 and be completed in 2019. Traffic delays should be expected.
