

PUBLIC HEARING CAMAS URBAN TREE PROGRAM

Over the past two years, we've been working on an urban tree program to better protect the city's trees. It was input from you, our Camas residents, who set us on this important course! The proposed Camas Urban Tree Program provides draft regulations to compliment the goals and policies that are within the city's comprehensive plan, <u>Camas 2035</u>. The proposal would amend the following sections of the Camas Municipal Code (CMC) to amend or add provisions regarding trees in the city: Chapter 3.54 (new) City Tree Fund; Chapter 12.04 – Sidewalk and Street Tree Maintenance; Chapter 12.32 – Park Rules and Regulations; Chapter 16.51 General Provisions for Critical Areas; miscellaneous references within Title 17 Land Development; Chapter 18.09 – Density and Dimensions; Chapter 18.13 Landscaping; and (repeal) Chapter 18.31 Sensitive Areas and Open Space.

Public Hearing: A public hearing will be held before Planning Commission on **June 19, 2018**, at 7:00 p.m., or soon thereafter, at Camas City Hall, located at 616 NE Fourth Avenue.
