“NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN” that a **public hearing** for minor amendments to the Camas Municipal Code, Chapter 18.15 and 18.27, Section 18.17.050, and other miscellaneous updates to Title 9, 12, 17 and 18, will be held before City Council on **Monday, October 21, 2019 at 7:00 p.m.**, or soon thereafter, at Camas City Hall, located at 616 NE Fourth Avenue, Camas. The proposed amendments to Chapter 18.15 include updates to electronic message board signs. Chapter 18.27 include updates to encourage the construction of Accessory Dwelling Units. Section 18.17.050 includes updates to clarify fence heights, and the miscellaneous updates contain general updates to Title 9, 12, 17, and 18.
