Project	NE Lake Road and NE Everett Street Intersection Improvements project

Location	The project area boundary extends approximately 500-feet to the north and 1,150 feet to the south of the existing intersection along NE Everett Street and approximately 750 feet northwest along NE Lake Road. The project site includes the city owned parcel east of the intersection (Parcel No. 124541000). The project is within the shoreline designation of "Urban Conservancy" and "Medium Intensity".
Applicant	City of Camas
Description	To reconstruct the existing signalized intersection at NE Lake Road and NE Ev- erett Street with roundabout improvements to accommodate for vehicular and pedestrian traffic. Intersection improvements include bike lanes, pedestri- an walkways, landscaping, hardscaping, fencing, signage, and lighting.
