## ANNUAL YARD DEBRIS DISPOSAL DAY

Date: Saturday, May 3, 2014

Time: **9 a.m. until 3 p.m.**

Location: Triangle Resources, 612 SE Union Street, Camas

Cost: No charge **Your donation of two canned food items is requested for local food banks.**

Sponsors: City of Camas and Triangle Resources

Offered **ONLY** to Camas residents living within the city limits. Proof of address may be requested.

**Permitted Materials:** Dispose of yard debris such as tree branches, blackberry bushes or other woody vegetation. **NO** sod, grass clippings, dirt, rocks, leaves, etc.

**Limited to one (1) free disposal of up to two (2) cubic yards of yard debris per household.**

## ANNUAL HOUSEHOLD AND HAZARDOUS WASTE DISPOSAL DAY

Date: Saturday, May 17, 2014

Time: **9 a.m. until 1 p.m.** Hazardous Waste – City and Clark County residents

**9 a.m. until 1 p.m.** Household Waste – Offered **ONLY** to Camas residents living within the city limits.

Proof of address may be requested.

Location: City of Camas Operations Center, 1620 SE 8<sup>th</sup> Ave. (Southeast Camas near SR 14)

Cost: No charge **Your donation of two canned food items is requested for local food banks.**

Sponsors: City of Camas, Waste Connections, and Clark County

### **9 a.m. until 1 p.m. Household Hazardous Waste Disposal**

**Permitted Hazardous Waste Materials include:** Most household hazardous waste accepted (i.e., paint, pesticides, solvents, most batteries, compact fluorescent light bulbs, motor oil, antifreeze, household cleaners, and products labeled toxic, poison, corrosive or flammable). For your safety and that of others, please try to keep products in their original containers and do not mix products together.

**Not Accepted:** explosives, ammunitions, biological material or business generated wastes.

**Limited to 25 gallons or 220 pounds of waste per household in containers smaller than 5 gallons.**

**Permitted Electronic Materials CHANGED FROM PREVIOUS YEARS:** computers, monitors, TVs, printers, VCRs, typewriters, cell phones, and other electronics.

**Not Accepted:** microwaves, smoke detectors, and large appliances.

**Permitted Block Foam:** Block foam (Styrofoam) clean, white and bagged/boxed.

**Not Accepted:** peanuts, plastic wrapped yellow urethane, spongy polypropylene, hot tub covers, food containers, and foam with cardboard, tape or metal attached.

### **9 a.m. until 1 p.m. Non-hazardous Household Waste Disposal**

Materials should be sorted into “wood, general waste, and metal” categories.

**Permitted Non-hazardous Household Waste Materials:** furniture, roofing material, scrap metal, plastic, wood, etc.

**NO YARD DEBRIS. NO TIRES. You may recycle tires at Les Schwab Tire Center for a nominal fee.**

**Limited to one (1) free disposal of up to two (2) cubic yards of waste per household.**

Each year, 5,000 tons of reusable items, such as furniture, clothing, toys, and books are thrown away. Please consider donating these items to local organizations rather than disposing of them during this event. Items brought to this event will be disposed of and not recycled.
