

ORDINANCE NO. 2007

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$26,000.00 from the Growth Management Act Capital Projects Fund to pay for a survey, wetlands delineation, archaeological assessment, traffic study, and other expenses to evaluate the feasibility of developing certain real property for a police station, and amending the Budget of the City of Camas for the year 1994 to provide for such expenditures.

WHEREAS, the City has entered into a Real Estate Purchase and Sale Agreement for the acquisition of certain real property to be developed for use as a police station, and

WHEREAS, said Real Estate Purchase and Sale Agreement is contingent upon the City undertaking certain feasibility studies to determine the suitability of said property for use as a police station, and

WHEREAS, such feasibility expenses include land clearing, a survey, a wetlands delineation, an archaeological survey, a traffic study, and a soils and environmental analysis, and

WHEREAS, the estimated expense of such studies is \$26,000.00, and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient unappropriated funds in the Growth Management Act Capital Projects Fund to pay for such expenditures, now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

The sum of \$26,000.00 is hereby appropriated from unappropriated funds in the Growth Management Act Capital Projects Fund and is allocated as follows:

This ordinance shall take force and be in effect five (5) days from and after its publication according to law.


