AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$20,000.00 from the General Fund to pay for consultant's fees for fire code compliance for the TSMC facility, and amending the Budget for the Year 1996 to provide for such expenditure.

WHEREAS, Taiwan Semi-Conductor Manufacturing Company (TSMC) has announced plans to construct a manufacturing facility within the City of Camas, and

WHEREAS, the TSMC facility will require extensive inspections and monitoring to insure compliance with the provisions of the uniform fire code, and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that such services are best rendered by third-party consultants, and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of such services is \$20,000.00, and WHEREAS, there are sufficient unappropriated funds in the General Fund to pay for such expenditures, now, therefore,

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

The sum of \$20,000.00 is hereby appropriated from unappropriated funds in the General Fund to pay for consultant's services for Fire Code enforcement and compliance in connection with the TSMC facility, and is allocated as follows:
