

ORDINANCE NO. 2091

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$126,700.00 from the General Fund to pay for radio communications equipment for the police department, and amending the budget for the year 1996 to provide for such expenditure.

WHEREAS, the regional police radio communication system will be converted to a 800 MHz simulcast trunking radio system as of January 1, 1997, and

WHEREAS, the police department needs to purchase and install radio equipment this year so as to be ready to go on-line as of January 1, 1997, and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of the radio equipment is \$109,700.00, and

WHEREAS, an additional \$17,000.00 is required to purchase five laptop computers and software to be installed in the police vehicles to utilize the new communications system, and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient unappropriated funds in the General Fund to pay for such expenditure,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

The sum of \$126,700.00 is appropriated from the General Fund to pay for police radio communications equipment, and is allocated as follows:
