

ORDINANCE NO. 2189

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$34,000.00 from the General Fund to pay for a salary analysis of city employee positions.

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to undertake a salary analysis of city employee positions, and

WHEREAS, the City has negotiated with the personnel firm of Johnson and Associates to undertake such work, and

WHEREAS, the anticipated expense for a salary study is \$34,000.00, and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient unappropriated funds in the General Fund to pay for such expenditure,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

The sum of \$34,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to pay for a salary study of city employee positions, and is allocated as follows:

Section II


Ordinance No. 2185 and the Budget for the City of Camas for the Year 1999 are amended to provide for the aforesated expenditure.

Section III


This ordinance shall take force and be in effect five (5) days from and after its publication according to law.
