ORDINANCE NO <u>246</u> 3

AN ORDINANCE amending Section 2.04.010 of the Camas Municipal Code by providing for two persons to be elected from each ward, and further providing for staggered terms for the positions in each ward.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

Section 2.04.010 of the Camas Municipal Code is amended to provide as follows:

2.04.010 **Election**

There shall be elected as members of the City Council, two persons from each ward, and one person At-Large; provided however, elections to positions to the City Council shall be by vote from the City At-Large. In each ward, the positions shall be denominated as Position No. 1 and Position No. 2. Position No. 1 in each ward and the At-Large position shall serve terms expiring at the end of 2007 and every four years thereafter. Position No. 2 in each ward shall serve a term expiring at the end of 2009, and every four years thereafter.

Section II

This ordinance shall take force and be in effect five (5) days from and after its publication according to law.
