

ORDINANCE NO. 1074

AN ORDINANCE reducing the speed limits on certain streets within the limits of the City of Camas.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

That Section 24 of Ordinance 906 and Section 4.04.240 of the Camas City Code are hereby amended to read as follows:

INCREASING SPEED LIMIT IN CERTAIN ZONES: It is hereby determined upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation that the speed permitted by state law upon the following streets is less than is necessary for safe operation of vehicles thereon by reason of the designation and signposting of said streets as arterial highways and (or) by reason of widely spaced intersections and it is hereby declared that the speed limit shall be as hereinafter set forth on those streets or parts of streets herein designated at the times specified when signs are erected giving notice thereof, but in no case shall the speed limit exceed thirty-five miles per hour, except upon limited access highways or designated approaches thereto.

<u>NAME OF STREET</u>	<u>SPEED LIMIT</u>	<u>AT ALL TIMES (OR) DURING DAYTIME</u>
N. E. Third Avenue from intersection with Sumner Street to east city limits	35 mph.	All times
S. E. Eighth Avenue from Union Street to east city limits	35 mph.	All times
N. W. Sixth Avenue from its intersection with N. W. Ash Street to westerly intersection with N. W. Norwood Street	35 mph.	All times

Section II

This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect five (5) days from and after its publication according to law.
