ORDINANCE NO. 1101

AN ORDINANCE decreasing the maximum speed on certain streets within the limits of the City of Camas and amending Section 25 of Ordinance No. 906 and Section 4.04.250 of the Camas City Code.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

That Section 25 of Ordinance No. 906 and Section 4.04.250 of the Camas City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

4.04.250 Decrease of state law maximum speed. It is hereby determined upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation that the speed permitted by state law outside of business and residence districts as applicable upon the following streets is greater than is reasonable or safe under the conditions found to exist upon such streets and it is hereby declared that the speed limit shall be fifteen or twenty miles per hour as herein set forth on those streets or parts of streets herein designated at the times herein specified when signs are erected giving notice thereof.

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Speed Limit</u>	<u>At all times (or) during nighttime</u>
N. E. Seventeenth from Division to Dallas	15 mph.	During hours swimming pool open to the public
N. E. Seventeenth from Division to Everett	20 mph.	At all other times
N. E. Fifteenth from Division to Everett	20 mph.	At all times
N. W. Norwood Street from N. W. Maple Lane to N. W. Eighth Avenue	15 mph.	At all times
N. W. Oregon Street	15 mph.	At all times
Norwood Drive	15 mph.	At all times

Section II

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days from and after its publication according to law.
