AN ORDINANCE amending Section 24 of Ordinance No. 9622 -and Section 4.04 .240 of the Camas City Code by decreasing the speed limit on a portion of N.E. Third Avenue.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:
Section I
406
That Section 24 of Ordinance No. 926, as last amended by Ordinance
No. 1160, and Section 4.04. 240 of the Camas City Code are hereby amended
as follows:
4.04. 240 Increasing speed limit in certain zones. It is hereby determined upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation that the speed permitted by state law upon the following streets is less than is necessary for safe operation of vehicles thereon by reason of the designation and sign posting of the streets as arterial highways and/or by reason of widely spaced intersections. It is hereby declared that the speed limit shall be as hereinafter set forth on those streets or parts of streets herein designated at the times specified when signs are erected giving notice thereof, but in no case shall the speed limit exceed forty (40) miles per hour, except upon limited access highways or designated approaches thereto.
