

RESOLUTION NO. 151

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of
Camas:

Section I.

The City Council of the City of Camas, Washington, hereby declares its intention to order the improvement of N. W. Park Street, from a point 60 feet South from its intersection with the South line of N. W. Fifth Avenue to its Southerly extremity thereof by grading, surfacing with crushed stone, constructing concrete curbs and applying a two (2) shot light bituminous surface thereon. All of said work shall be done according to plans and specifications prepared by the City Engineer.

Section II.

It is proposed that the entire cost and expense of said improvements shall be borne by and assessed against the property liable therefor, as provided by law.

Section III.

All persons who may desire to object to such improvements are hereby notified to appear before and present their objections to the City Council or a committee composed thereof at a public meeting to be held in the Council chambers at the City Hall, in the City of Camas, Washington, at the hour of 7:00 P. M., on Monday, May 18, 1959, which time and place is fixed for hearing all matters relating to such proposed improvements and all objections thereto, and for determining the method of payment for said improvements.

Section IV.

The City Engineer is hereby directed to submit to the City Council and to file with the City Clerk at or prior to the time and date noted above, the data required by ordinance and by law. Such data shall include:

a. The estimated cost and expense of each separate and continuous unit of said improvements, and the total cost of such improvements;

b. A statement of the proportionate amount of such estimated cost and expense which should be borne by the property within the proposed assessment district;

c. A report certifying in detail the local improvement assessments outstanding and unpaid against the property in the proposed district;

d. A statement of the aggregate actual valuation of the real estate, including twenty-five (25%) per cent of the actual valuation of the improvements within said district according to the valuation last placed upon it for the purpose of general taxation;

e. A diagram or print showing thereon the lots, tracts and parcels of land and other property which will be specially benefited thereby and the estimated amount of the cost and expense of such improvement to be borne by each lot, tract or parcel of land or other property.

Section V.

The City Clerk is directed to give notice of the hearing on this Resolution as provided by law and to cause this Resolution to be published in the official newspaper of the City as provided by law.
