

RESOLUTION NO. 581

A RESOLUTION providing for the decrease of the speed limit in certain zones.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS as follows:

Section I

It is hereby determined upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation that the speed permitted by state law upon certain streets is more than is reasonable and safe under the conditions found to exist upon such streets.

Section II

The speed limit for the following streets or portions thereof herein designated shall be twenty (20) miles per hour at the times herein specified when signs are erected giving notice thereof:

East First Avenue from N.E. Joy Street to N.E. Third Avenue	At all times
N.E. Fifteenth Avenue from Division to Everett Street	At all times
N.E. Seventeenth Avenue from Division to Everett Street	At all times
N.W. Benton Street from N.W. Twelfth Avenue to N.W. Eighteenth Avenue	At all times
N.W. Ivy Street from N.W. Sixth Avenue to N.W. Seventh Avenue	At all times
N.W. Logan Street from N.W. Sixth Avenue to N.W. Seventh Avenue	At all times
Norwood Drive	At all times
N.W. Norwood Street from N.W. Maple Lane to N.W. Eighth Avenue	At all times
N.W. Oregon Street	At all times
N.E. Third Avenue Loop	At all times
