

RESOLUTION NO. 262

A RESOLUTION authorizing the Clerk of the City of Camas to be the certifying officer of the City to authenticate vouchers filed and designating said position as the "Finance Officer."

WHEREAS, a provision of Chapter 116 of the 1965 Session Laws provided all claims filed with the City for payment had to bear the signature of a city officer authorized to certify and authenticate the validity of said claims when so presented; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires that the City Clerk act as such certifying officer;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Camas as follows:

Section I

Pursuant to Chapter 116 of the 1965 Session Laws of the State of Washington, the Clerk of the City of Camas be and he is hereby designated as the official of the City to certify the authenticity of all claims hereinafter filed for payment for materials or services furnished or labor performed for the City. That in the absence of the Clerk the Deputy of said office shall serve as such certifying officer.

Section II

That the Clerk of the City of Camas shall be known and designated as the Finance Officer when certifying claims filed with the City for payment.
