#### Camas Fire Marshal Calls for Caution in Purchasing and Discharging Fireworks

Fire Marshal Randy Miller urges citizens to use caution in purchasing fireworks. Be sure the fireworks you purchase are legal to possess and discharge.

#### Legal Fireworks

Novelty & Smoke Items  
Sparklers and Spinners  
Multi Aerials  
Helicopters  
Cones and Fountains  
Wheels  
Roman Candles  
Reloadable Mortars (1 3/4" or smaller)

#### Legal only on Tribal Lands

Firecrackers and Chasers  
Bottle Rockets  
Missiles and Rockets

#### Illegal Explosive Devices

M-80's or larger  
Cherry Bombs  
Tennis Ball Bombs  
Legal Fireworks that are altered  
Dry Ice Bombs

Possession of illegal explosive devices, including altered legal fireworks, is a FELONY.

### **Date and times fireworks can be discharged within the city limits of Camas:**

<b>June 28<sup>th</sup></b>	<b>Between 12:00 noon and 11:00 p.m.</b>
<b>June 29<sup>th</sup> through July 3<sup>rd</sup></b>	<b>Between 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m.</b>
<b>July 4<sup>th</sup></b>	<b>Between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 midnight.</b>
<b>July 5<sup>th</sup></b>	<b>Between 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m.</b>
<b>December 31<sup>st</sup></b>	<b>Between 6 p.m. and 1:00 a.m.</b>

Use only state legal fireworks purchased at a state and city licensed stand. Check for restrictions or bans in the area you will be discharging your fireworks.
