



CAMAS POOL RULES

Main Pool All ages, restrictions may apply to deep areas of pool based on skill ability.

The following rules have been set for the Camas Municipal Pool to ensure the safety of all our patrons.

- Children 6 and younger (with or without a lifejacket) must be within arms reach of an adult/guardian over 18 at all times.
- Smoking is not permitted within 25 feet from the pool building.
- No street clothes (including cut-offs, T-shirts, and jean shorts). We do allow plain clean white shirts or those that are specifically made to be used for swimming in a treated pool .
- No running, pushing, or horseplay.
- Gum, food, drink or tobacco is not permitted in the pool area. Please enjoy your picnic lunches out in the park. Water is encouraged in non-breakable containers.
- Glass containers are not allowed in the pool building.
- All floatation devices must be Coast Guard approved and in good condition.
- No jumping or diving from the side of the swimming pool, only allowed in designated areas.
- Long hair **MUST** be restrained with a rubber band.
- Open sores, bandages, athlete's foot, etc., are not permitted in the pool area.
- Everyone must take a cleansing shower before entering the pool. Please avoid wearing lotions, hair sprays/gels and makeup when entering the pool.
- No snorkeling masks or scuba equipment allowed.
- Everyone in the water must pay.
- Follow directions when given by lifeguards or other staff.
- **DO NOT SWIM** if you have had intestinal illness, stomachache, or diarrhea in the past two weeks. Swim diapers are required for children who are not potty trained. Please do not change diapers on deck. The locker rooms are available for changing diapers and swim diapers.

Age limitation in pools are as follows:

Baby Pool 5 and under and guardians.

Junior Pool 8 and under and guardians.
